- b. **Bringing to the attention of the RADC Benevolent Fund any cases of members, their widows, children and dependants who may require assistance due to poverty or distress.**
- c. **Assisting in finding employment for its members.**
- d. **Organising social events for members.**

ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP of the Association is open to:

1. **All Ranks past and present who have served with The Army Dental Corps or the Royal Army Dental Corps (including TA and TAVR).**
2. **All ranks of the ATS and QARANC who have served in the dental trades of these Corps.**

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP is open to members past and present of all arms who have been attached to the RADC for duty and to civilians trained by the RADC or established civil servants employed within the RADC.

The present SUBSCRIPTION is £3 per year (£ 15 payable every 3 years). Membership includes a copy of the Association News Letter each Spring and a copy of the RADC Bulletin each Autumn. New Life Membership is no longer available. Members are requested to notify the Regimental Secretary of any change of address.

HONORARY MEMBERSHIP - WW2 veterans may be nominated or may apply for membership. The number of Honorary Members is limited to 50. Honorary Members have no voting rights.
